Grant County Feeders, a 110,000-head feedyard completed in 1974, is located near the town of Ulysses, Kansas. Ulysses, named after the 18th President of the United States, Ulysses S. Grant, has a population of 6,200. Five Rivers Grant County Feeders is a proud member of the Ulysses and Grant County Kansas community.

Grant County Feeders is the only feedyard with its own supplement plant. The Grant County Feeders supplement plant produces nutritional supplements for the five southern Five Rivers feedyards, delivering over 200 tons per day.

Grant County was built by Stratford of Texas and DeKalb and has carried the names of Continental Grain or ContiBeef and Five Rivers Ranch Cattle Feeding.
